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CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG – Chairman Robert Eppley called the meeting to order at 7:34 AM at the Middlesex Township Building.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON ORDINANCE 1-2003 AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 2.03 AND ALL PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE XXII, RT- RESIDENTIAL TOWNE DISTRICT

Chairman Eppley turned the meeting over to Township Solicitor Keith Brenneman. Mr. Brenneman noted that this was the time and place for the public hearing on an ordinance to amend the Township Zoning Ordinance with respect to the RT Residential Towne District. This hearing has been properly advertised two times in the Sentinel on January 27 and February 3, 2003 with the full text of the Ordinance being provided to the Sentinel and the Cumberland County Commissioner's Office as required by law. The Ordinance was provided to the Cumberland County Planning Commission and the Middlesex Township Planning Commission 30 day prior to the hearing. Mr., Brenneman entered several items as exhibits. At the conclusion of the testimony Mr. Brenneman turned the meeting over to Mr. Eppley and Mr. Shughart made a motion to close the hearing seconded by Mr. Stabile and it passed unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT - None

Mr. Stabile made a motion to adopt **Ordinance 1-2003** relating to the Residential Towne District. Mr. Shughart seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved. Mr. Brenneman stated that it would be effective 5 days from today.

Mr. Carpenter stated that Mr. **Rolan Fenton** wants to subdivide his property which is all in Silver Spring Township, although he uses Middlesex Township as his address, he is asking for an exception to paying additional fees in Middlesex Township. Mr. Shughart made a motion to waive the submission fee for the subdivision and Mr. Stabile seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

Mrs. Justh presented a letter from **PMRS to the Township** accepting the agreement with the Police officers and the Township regarding the police pension. Mr. Stabile made a motion to

ratify Mr. Eppley's signature on the PMRS Agreement effective 2/12/03 seconded by Mr. Shughart and passed unanimously.

Mr. Long asked to make comments to the Supervisors regarding the **Residential Towne Ordinance** and the fact that he appreciates what has been done.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 PM on a motion by Mr. Shughart and seconded by Mr. Stabile.
