CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES of 2 and 25 February – Mr. Don Geistwhite made a motion to approve the minutes of February 2nd and 25th, seconded by Mr. Stabile and the motion carried unanimously.

Zoning – Ordered to file. Mr. Carpenter stated that Petro is installing idle air venting at the truck stop. The Army Heritage site will be doing some outside display work at the complex. Mr. Carpenter explained that there seems to be a great deal of interest in development. Sally Holbert has been contacted by Mr. Carpenter to give the Township an estimate of a Conservation Subdivision Design to update the Township Comprehensive Plan. Mr. Grove explained that you may do all the work, but not get the funds to supplement the financial output. Mr. Grove suggested that he would contact Mr. Jeff Kelly about funding and work up a scope of work for the RF District.

Municipal Authority – Mr. Geistwhite reported that the MTMA are wrapping things up for well 7.

OLD BUSINESS

PA Turnpike/Bill Zizzi- Mr. Zizzi reported that he is representing his parents and their property on the Harrisburg Pike, and the fact that the Turnpike Commission will be moving the power lines and taking of the property by emanate domain. It is Mr. Zizzi's understanding that the Turnpike Commission will not be filing a Land Development Plan with the township. It is the intend of Middlesex Township to have the Turnpike Commission file a Land Development Plan according to Mr. Stabile. Mr. Stabile made a motion to include the Kee and West Pennsboro Township vs The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission history as reported by Mr. Tony Zizzi into the record of this meeting. Mr. Geistwhite seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution 05-06 Increasing the Tax Certificate by the Tax Collector to \$5.00 – Any decision on the Resolution was tabled until Mrs. Justh can research the issue with Tax Collector Penny Davis.

Mrs. Sharon Brown, of Wolfs Bridge Road in Middlesex Township, expressed concern about the situation with her neighbors, that she spoke to Mr. Carpenter about. Mr. Brenneman reassured her that the Township is trying to get the problem resolved and will be in contact with her, but would not address litigation in a public meeting.

Resolution 05-07 Requesting Officials to Maintain Carlisle Barracks and the Army War College – A motion was made by Mr. Stabile to adopt Resolution 05-07. The motion was seconded Mr. Geistwhite and passed unanimously. The Supervisors asked Mrs. Justh to send a copy of the resolution to the following; Arlan Spector, Will Gabig, Pat Vance, Bill Shuster, Todd Platts, Rick Santorum, Governor Rendell, and DCED.
