CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG: Chairman Geistwhite called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. in the Middlesex Township Building, leading the pledge to the flag.

Zoning – Mr. Carpenter submitted the monthly Zoning Report. There was a brief discussion of the report. Report entered into record. Mr. Carpenter then reported that he is working on a building permit for a Chinese Restaurant to be located at Keystone Arms. There is another restaurant proposed for the same area. There has been some demolition permits issued for run down mobile homes in the Township.

Recreation/Recycling Coordinator – Mrs. Jumper submitted the Recreation Report. Report entered into record.

Fire/EMC – Mr. Beam submitted the monthly Fire/EMC Report. There was a brief discussion of the report. Report entered into record.

Municipal Authority – Chairman Geistwhite reported that things are going well with Municipal Authority.

Secretary – Mrs. Gault reminded the Supervisors that the Inter-Municipal Meeting is scheduled for March 12, 2015, 7:30 a.m. at Dickinson Township.

Mrs. Gault mentioned that a resident who is a Marine Veteran had inquired whether the Township would be interested in a mail box type of box for proper flag disposal. The Marines will be the ones to properly dispose of the flags with a ceremony they have. The Supervisors are in favor of having a disposal box placed at the Township.

OLD BUSINESS:

Planning Commission Member Appointment: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed to appoint Mr. Randy Waggoneer as Planning Commission Member for the unexpired term of Mr. Sean Oldfield.

MS4 Meeting Update: Mr. Carpenter reported that he attended a meeting regarding MS4. There were representatives from the Letort Collaborative Group as well as representatives from DEP to answer questions. Middlesex should be receiving the notification and application sometime in 2017. The Township will have 6 months to apply for a permit by March 2018. The initial fee is \$5,000.00 with an annual renewal fee of \$500.00. This is early in the stages. The Supervisors would like the staff to keep them informed as this progresses.

NEW BUSINESS:

Love's Travel Stops Special Exception or Variance Application for Truck Service: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed the Supervisors take no position on the Special Exception or Variance Application for Love's Travel Stops but if granted request that the conditions as presented are attached.

Mr. Carpenter reported that he did an inspection at the County Home. They are opening a modern 39 unit rehabilitation facility. Mr. Carpenter stated that they plan to open next week.
