CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG: Chairman Geistwhite called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. in the Middlesex Township Municipal Building.

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR NATHAN & JENA JOHNS AT 3360 SPRING ROAD: This issue has been tabled until the April 7, 2021 meeting.

DEP MUNICIPAL NOTIFICATION OF PLANNED LAND DEVELOPMENT FOR CHAPTER 102 PERMITS PERTAINING TO CUMBERLAND PRESERVE: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed to execute the DEP Municipal Notification of Planned Land Development for Chapter 102 Permits pertaining to Cumberland Preserve.

AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE A 2021 FORD F250 PICKUP TRUCK WITH A SNOWPLOW: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to authorize the purchase of a 2021 Ford F250 pickup truck with a snowplow.

TRINDLE ROAD AND ARMY HERITAGE DRIVE TRAFFIC CAMERAS: Director of Public Safety Mr. Kingsborough reported that South Middleton Township is planning in phases to put up traffic cameras and would like to do so on the traffic lights Middlesex Township maintains at Trindle Road and Army Heritage Drive. These cameras are tied to the PSP Barracks where traffic can be monitored. There will be no cost to Middlesex, and in exchange Middlesex would be able to connect to the cameras that are being installed by Hilton's Lock & Security. Mr. Kingsborough will discuss with the Solicitor Mr. Brenneman as to whether an Inter-Municipal Agreement is needed. On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed to authorize the Director of Public Safety to proceed with arrangements of the installation of traffic cameras at Trindle Road and Army Heritage Drive.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting at 7:45 a.m. to Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter. The Board reconvened at 7:55 a.m.

On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to execute the Global Settlement & General Release Agreement between Middlesex Township, Barry Sherman and Andrew Wolfe.
