

**MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP

Chairman Robert Eppley called the meeting to order at 7:47 AM in the Middlesex Township Building.

PHEASANT CROSSING STREET TREE MAINTENANCE BOND – Harry L. Ramage requested that the Township release security for street trees at Pheasant Crossings. Engineer Grove told the Supervisors that the trees look fairly good, but some need to be tied and staked. Supervisor Stabile suggested that the security be extended for 60 days to give time to determine if all the trees will survive. Mr. Stabile suggested Mr. Ramage be contacted by Mr. Carpenter concerning the extension.

PILOT TRAVEL CENTER LETTER OF CREDIT AND AS-BUILT DRAWINGS – Solicitor Brenneman has no as-built drawings from Pilot, and has not had any response from his letter at this time. Mr. Stabile explained that a LOC and as-built are demanded at this time, particularly in light of the hazardous spill that occurred at Pilot. Mr. Stabile explained that this problem needs to be corrected.

CUMBERLAND VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT REQUEST FOR DEDICATION OF LEIDA DRIVE – Engineer Grove verified that the as-built was received, but recommendation for dedication of Leida Drive is contingent upon the following: Mr. Grove's inspection of the road, a resolution from Mr. Brenneman, approval of a separate plot plan being attached, 18 month security for maintenance and submission and approval for deed of dedication. Dedication will appear on the Wednesday night May 3, 2000 agenda.

RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT – LAND USE AND TRAFFIC IMPACT STUDY FOR I-81 EXIT 12 – Mr. Stabile is a member of the task force for the Exit 12 study and gave a brief explanation of the purpose of the Township providing a Resolution in support. Mr. Stabile asked if a Resolution could be drafted for Wednesday night May 3rd, by Solicitor Brenneman.

APPOINTMENT OF PROJECT OFFICER – FOR DEP RECYCLING BIN GRANT – Mr. Stabile made a motion to appoint Secretary/Treasurer Mary Justh as the Grantee with DEP for the Grant Application process for recycling bins. Mr. Eppley seconded the motion and it carry.

Mr. Stabile indicated that the Township has retained **Attorney White for Police Arbitration** addressed in his letter of April 25, 2000 not to exceed \$1,000.00 plus travel expenses.

Mr. Grove will have a recommendation to the Township on Tuesday before the Meeting on Wednesday May 3, 2000 concerning **The McNaughton proposed amendment of Article XVI**. Mr. Grove is also doing a proposal of where Water & Sewer might be extended in the Township.

Mr. Carpenter explained to the Supervisors that the **Fry house in Carlisle Springs** has been torn down and a new home is in place.

Mr. Carpenter reported that a notice has gone out concerning the **trailers on Stover Drive**. He is hopeful that they comply with the terms of the letter.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 am for Executive Session.
