CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG

Chuck Shughart called the meeting to order at 7:051 PM in the Municipal Building. Mr. Keith Brenneman led the assembly in the pledge to the flag.

PUBLIC COMMENT - None

VOTING MACHINE DEMONSTRATION

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Minutes of 31 March, 5 and 28 April were tabled at the request of Mr. Stabile, until Mr. Geistwhite is in attendance at the next workshop meeting.

AUTHORIZE PAYMENT OF BILLS – Mr. Stabile made a motion to authorize payment of bills per the list for April. Mr. Shughart seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

REPORTS

Solicitor – Mr. Brenneman reported that he has the Ordinance ready to be advertised for Claremont Road.

Engineer – None

Police – Ordered to file.

Zoning – Mr. Carpenter stated that the Giant Foods would like to provide a scoreboard for the baseball field number 7. This will be a lighted sign. Mr. Stabile made a motion to allow Giant to erect a lighted scoreboard on the baseball field in the park and that they maintain the sign indefinitely, bearing all the cost. Mr. Charles Shughart seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Recreation – Ordered to file.

Fire/EMC – Ordered to file.

Municipal Authority – No report

Secretary – Mrs. Justh asked the Supervisors to consider allowing the staff to purchase a controller for the copier that would allow the staff to make multiple copies from our individual computers. Mr. Shughart and Mr. Stabile asked Mrs. Justh to get the information on the controller and if it would be cost effective.

OLD BUSINESS

Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission – Mr. Carpenter explained that he has been in contact with the Turnpike Commission and plan will be forth coming to Mr. Grove. Mr. Carpenter has also been in contact with Mr. Zizzi and it looks like they have reached an agreement with Zizzi's.

Burning Ban – After some discussion about the Burn Ban, Mr. Stabile made a motion to keep Middlesex Township's Burn Ban on as long as Cumberland County has there Burn Ban on and when the County lifts theirs, then the Township's will be lifted.

NEW BUSINESS

Third Request for Reduction of Security for Keystone Arms – Mr. Stabile stated that this is an item for Mr. Grove. Mrs. Justh stated that Mr. Grove would be prepared for the next meeting on May 19th with his recommendation.

Mr. Carpenter told the Supervisors about enforcement action that he has taken with respect to the **Wert** Property. Mr. Carpenter stated that the property has been sold. Mr. Brenneman recommended that the citation should not be withdrawn at this time. Mr. Carpenter has been in contact regarding the **Thumma** property. There is one on Spring Road, **Geeseman** property that had several junked cars, and the cars have been removed. Mr. Carpenter has taken action against the **Easer** property on Wolfs Bridge Road and is working Chief Sherman on that. Also, the individual on Wolfs Bridge Road is only renting to 4 individuals, so that is going well according to Mr. Carpenter.

Mr. Shughart made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:49 PM. The motion was seconded by Mr. Stabile.
