APPOINTMENT OF SOLICITOR TO THE ZONING HEARING BOARD: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed to appoint Jennifer B. Hipp, Law Offices of James D. Bogar, Shiremanstown, PA as Solicitor to the Zoning Hearing Board effective June 1, 2014.

BID AWARD FOR SALT SHED: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed to award the bid for the salt shed in the amount of \$55,900.00 to Sollenberger Silos, LLC, Chambersburg, PA.

MASU GROUP, LLC – PINE HILL INDUSTRIAL PARK, LOT 6A – REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF IMPROVEMENT SECURITY: The Supervisors acknowledge receipt of this request. No action will be taken until a report is provided by the Township Engineer.

Mr. Carpenter reported on Toigo Farms that the property sold last week and they will spend approximately 1.7 million to develop the greenhouse. There is still no start date for construction.

Mr. Goodhart commended Chief Sherman and the Zoning Officer Mr. Carpenter for the great job they did in declaring the mobile home in Regency North unfit for habitation and removing the children and their grandmother from the home.
