Chairman Geistwhite called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. in the Middlesex Township Building.

PUBLIC HEARING: Chairman Geistwhite announced that the first order of business is a Public Hearing in which Chairman Geistwhite then turned the meeting over to the Township Solicitor Mr. Brenneman. Mr. Brenneman reported that the public hearing is for the proposed amendment of the Middlesex Township Zoning Ordinance with respect to fence and wall height amending section 14.19.A and section 14.19.D. Mr. Brenneman gave a summary of the procedures followed prior to the hearing. Mr. Brenneman then turned the hearing over to Chairman Geistwhite. There being no questions or comments, at the direction of the Solicitor, Chairman Geistwhite declared the hearing closed.

PROPOSED ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE 6 – 2019: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed to adopt Ordinance 6 – 2019 amending the Middlesex Township Zoning Ordinance with respect to fence and wall height.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Mr. Jerry Trolinger, 2551 Spring Road was present to discuss a water erosion problem occurring on his property located in North Middleton, which he attributes to Phase I & Phase II of Meadowbrook Farm. After much discussion, it was recommended that Mr. Trolinger obtain an attorney to address his issue.

PROPOSED ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE 7 - 2019: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to adopt Ordinance 7 – 2019 amending the Middlesex Township Pretreatment Program of March 1989.

PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBER RESIGNATION: On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Vice-Chairman Larson, it was unanimously agreed to accept with regret the resignation of Mr. Jim Dries from the Planning Commission and to authorize Zoning Officer Mr. Carpenter to write a letter of appreciation for Mr. Dries's service.

There being no further business, on the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting at 7:59 a.m. to Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter with no action to be taken by the Supervisors.
