Chairman Robert Eppley called the meeting to order at 7:35 AM in the Middlesex Township Building.

PUBLIC COMMENT – None

Supervisor Stabile made a motion to adopt **ORDINANCE 4-2000 – Providing for a Maximum Weight Limitation of 10 Tons for Vehicles and 16 Tons for Combinations on the Bridge Over Letort Spring Run at Shady Lane (T-510)**. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Shughart and passed unanimously.

Solicitor Brenneman presented an **ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WATER AND SANITARY SEWER DISTRICTS for Meadowbrook farms** to create a separate rate district for the Municipal Authority. Mr. Stabile made a motion to advertise the ordinance for enactment at the next Workshop Meeting seconded by Mr. Shughart and passed unanimously.

Mr. Grove will be reporting on **Pheasant Crossing Street Tree Maintenance** at the Regular Meeting on July 5th according to Chief Sherman.

Mr. Stabile made a motion to appoint **Mr. Robert Eppley as the Official Municipal Voting Delegate and Zoning Officer Mark Carpenter be the Alternate to the Task Force for the Cumberland/Perry Counties Congestion Management System Study**. The motion was seconded by Mr. Shughart and was passed unanimously.

Mr. Vic Stabile made a motion to **reappoint Bruce Bistline and Doris Law as Planning Commission Members** seconded by Mr. Shughart and passed unanimously for a four year term.

Mr. Brenneman gave the Supervisors an update on the **Deed Of Dedication for Leida Road** that Mr. Grove hopes to have it on the agenda Wednesday night. According to Mr. Brenneman the Legal description does not correspond with the plot plan and needs to be corrected before acceptance for dedication.

Mr. Brenneman reported that they have put back the language that the Township is not committing to anything more than what we are legally obligated to provide with respect to the **Army Heritage Center Memorandum Of Understanding**. Mr. Shughart made a motion to sign the Memorandum seconded by Mr. Stabile and passed unanimously.

Chief Sherman reported on **PennDOT District 8-0 Request For Betterment Program Candidates**. Last year's list included South Middlesex Road improvements, Rt. 944 and Deer lane, and the intersection of Rt. 34 and Rt. 944. Chief Sherman explained that the intersection is very dark and hard to see at night, but if the Township wants a light PennDOT must be contacted for approval and the possibility exists that the Township would be responsible to maintain the light. Mr. Shughart would like to contact PennDOT by phone first to get a feel for what would be Township responsibility.

Mr. Stabile asked if Mr. Bowman had been contacted with the results of the **PennDOT Letter Concerning Rt. 944 And Deer Lane**. Mr. Stabile directed Mrs. Justh to contact Mr. Mallin and ask what time the study was done. Chief Sherman explained that a lot of calls come in complaining about excessive speed and the amount of traffic, making it difficult for people to get out on Rt. 944.

Mrs. Justh informed the Supervisors that the **Recycling Bin Grant** check has been received.

Mr. Shughart made a motion to sign the **PennDOT Authorization to plant evergreen trees** in the Township right-of-way. Mr. Stabile seconded that motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Stabile asked to go to Executive Session for a few moments concerning **possible legal action by Dennis Lebo**. Mr. Stabile stated that enforcement needs to be more strict concerning what action is taken with people like this. Mr. Carpenter told the Supervisors that a hearing is scheduled for August 9th concerning the Lebo Plan.

Mr. Eppley stated that he and Mr. Carpenter were over at the **Junk Yard** and have decided to hold their license until it is cleaned up. Chief Sherman asked why we haven't taken action and notified them how many days they have to comply since it has been determined to be a hazard.

Mrs. Justh asked the Supervisors what plan of action is to be taken concerning **trash disposal**. Mr. Stabile asked if **York Waste** could come to the workshop meeting at the end of July to give us some prices, to help determine what action needs to be taken concerning renewing the contract or advertising for another hauler.

Mr. Brenneman explained that **Pilot plans** are to be with Engineer Grove today and should be ready for the July 5th Meeting.

After a brief executive session Mr. Stabile made a motion to defend any action from **Mr. Lebo** concerning property on Stover Drive, and enforce the agreement the Township has with **Andy Anderson Estate the property owner and operator Cycil LeBaron**. Mr. Shughart seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 am.
