Chairman Robert Eppley called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM in the Middlesex Twp Building.

DRAFT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN REVIEW – The order of business for the meeting was reviewing the Comprehensive Plan comments from the Planning Commission. Several recommendations were added and a request from the supervisors to delete the transportation map and map bullets.

Mrs. Justh explained the advantages of going with Custom Blue: 1. Prescriptions that were not covered by Health Assurance are being covered by Custom Blue, 2. Although the numbers have not been totaled it looks like a savings will be realized. 3. The lifetime benefit will be unlimited rather than 1,000,000.00 with Health Assurance.

Mr. Stabile gave details of what he has learned about the Army Museum and what we can expect from the Federal Government with respect to the Museum. Mr. Stabile suggested that a letter be written by Keith Brenneman to the Army Museum asking them to consider comments from Middlesex Township. That Mr. Grove be given the opportunity to look at the Stormwater Plan, Roads and Site Plan for the Army Museum, and that the Municipal Authority be given the opportunity to review the water and sewer. Mr. Stabile will make arrangements for a meeting to discuss outstanding issues. Mr. Stabile asked that the costs be kept to a minimum, and this review would be part of Middlesex Township's contribution to the Museum.

Mr. Stabile reviewed the progress with the Inter-connector between Rt. 81 and the Turnpike.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:46.
