Chairman Robert Eppley called the meeting to order at 7:34 AM in the Middlesex Twp Building.

PUBLIC COMMENT - Mr. Wayne Tritt of 24 Old Stone House Road, Silver Spring Township and Mr. Steve Stromlox spoke on behalf of residents that would like to voice their concerns with adding North to the end of Old Stone House Road. Mr. Tritt would ask the Supervisors to please cooperate with the other Townships in solving the problems with ambulances going to the wrong addresses. Mr. Shughart suggested that the road be completely renumbered to solve the problem. Mr. Shughart explained that the signage length, by adding north may be too much, but the Supervisors will try to accommodate the other Townships with any suggestions they may have to the problem.

AWARD OF LINE STRIPING BID - Mrs. Justh gave the bid amount for Ross Industries of York at a price of \$23,691.00 and Alpha Space of Fayetteville bid amount of \$13,858.00. Mr. Shughart made a motion to award the bid to Alpha Space the lowest bidder. Mr. Eppley seconded the motion and it passed.

RESOLUTION FOR STUDY SUPPORT OF THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY I-81

CORRIDOR - Mrs. Justh presented the resolution requesting that the Supervisors consider a corridor study. Mr. Shughart and Mr. Eppley decided that this resolution should be tabled until the August 7th meeting since Mr. Stabile is directly involved in the study.

NEW COPIER CONSIDERATION - Mrs. Justh did a comparison of all 5 copiers, purchasing outright and total of what a lease would cost. Mr. Gavin Frisch of Harrisburg Copiers presented the Supervisors with a report comparing the Canon and Toshiba copiers. Mr. Frisch stated that Harrisburg Copier could meet the rate of Canon at .011 rather than what is stated at .014. in their proposal. Mr. Shughart suggested that Mr. Frisch give us the new proposal in writing. Mr. Shughart suggested that the Supervisors review and make a decision at the August 7th.

Mrs. Justh gave the Supervisors **2 additional applications** to fill the position of Fran Socha for the Recreation Board. The Rec Board will make a recommendation to the Supervisors.

Chief Barry Sherman stated that a problem has been observed on **Claremont Road** and the drainage along the Road at the Bob Line property. Chief Sherman suggested that a letter be sent to the property owner concerning the closing of the drainage swale along Claremont Road. Mr.

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Shughart authorized Mr. Spare to write a letter to demand all excavation or fill activity cease immediately at the Mr. Robert Line, Jr. property on Claremont Road.

Mrs. Justh asked if there was a representative from the Township willing to attend the meeting concerning **volunteer fire fighters**. There will be someone attending the meeting to represent the Township in August.

Mr. Shughart asked **Mr. Reiff** if he had business to discuss with the Supervisors. Mr. Reiff would like to discuss his property with the Supervisors. Mr. Shughart suggested that Mr. Carpenter contact Mr. Reiff with the meeting date.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:16 AM.

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
