Fire/EMC - Mr. Ed Beam reported on the fire at 195 Beagle Club Road and all personal did everything in their power to prevent loss of life and protect the personal as well as counseling for the family and the firefighters. The Fire Departments that were involved were New Kingston, Union, North Middleton, Washington, Mechanicsburg, Cumberland Goodwill, and Hampden Township. Police departments represented were North Middleton and Middlesex. EMS Departments were Carlisle Community, Silver Spring Township, West Shore and Yellow Breeches also, West Shore/CR ALS, Penn State Life Lion, Stat 13 Med Evac Responding, Cumberland County 911 Frank Kramer, Dispatchers and Staff, the South Central Pa – Critical Incident Stress management Team, Tom Moriority and Cumberland County Critical Inc. Stress Team, Cumberland County Public Information Office, Cumberland county Coroners Office, PSP Fire Marshall, and the American Red Cross. Fire Chief Ed Beam has begun a campaign to raise funds to purchase smoke alarms. Fire Chief Beam would like to distribute smoke alarms for those individuals that may be unable to obtain them on their own.

OLD BUSINESS

Keystone Arms Release of Improvement Funds – Mr. Grove presented the supervisors with a memo recommending a reduction of security for construction of the required improvements in the amount \$164,774.68 to a new balance of \$1,027,089.12. Mr. Carpenter explained the plan of the strip mall to the Supervisors. Mr. Brenneman explained that an intermunicipal agreement will be necessary. Mrs. Justh told the Supervisors that the Municipal Authority's meeting is later than this meeting and they were requesting an answer from the Board. Mr. Geistwhite made a motion to approve this request subject to an intermunicipal agreement. Mr. Shughart seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Release of Security for Phase 3 & 4 Harmony Hall Townhouses/McCorkel Construction Services – Mr. Grove stated that he would be reporting on the release of security for the workshop meeting at the end of the month.
