Chairman Geistwhite called the meeting to order at 7:30 am in the Middlesex Township Building.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Mr. Stan Tarka, 210 N. Old Stonehouse Road, asked for an update on where the Township is with virtual meetings? Township Manager responded that she has explored the idea, however, has not made it a priority. The Supervisors have not really discussed the idea, have continued to conduct meetings open to the public during the COVID-19 crisis, practice social distancing and will consider the suggestion.

**FINAL MAJOR SUBDIVISION PLAN FOR MEADOWBROOK FARMS PHASE IX:** Zoning Officer Mr. Carpenter provided the Supervisors with the plan for Meadowbrook Farms Phase IX. He reported that this is 11 lots on 5 acres. The plan has been reviewed by the Township Planning Commission, County Planning Commission and Township Engineer Bud Grove. Mr. Carpenter is requesting action to be taken at the September 2, 2020 meeting.

**MOTION TO SCHEDULE A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SHEETZ REQUEST FOR A RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER AT THE SEPTEMBER 25, 2020 WORKSHOP MEETING:** On the motion of Chairman Geistwhite, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to authorize the Township Solicitor Mr. Brenneman to schedule a public hearing on the Sheetz request for a restaurant liquor license transfer to be held at the September 25, 2020 Workshop Meeting.

Township Manager Mrs. Gault confirmed the Supervisors agreed to the verbiage that will be used in the Fall Newsletter pertaining to Trick-or-Treat.

Roadmaster Mr. Zook informed the Supervisors that he spoke with the Foreman for the Wolfs Bridge project and it is back on schedule. If the construction season lasts into the Fall without any further delays, there is a possibility it will be open in the Fall for traffic and final paving in the Spring.

Zoning Officer Mr. Carpenter reported that the Toigo Organic Farms have began putting a new roof on the barn.
