NEW BUSINESS:

Raymond C. Wickard request for relief from on-lot sewage system replacement area requirement: On the motion of Vice – Chairman Larson, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to waive the requirement per Section 6c. of Township Ordinance No. 1 – 1999 to provide an on-lot sewage system replacement area for unimproved 4.07 acre lot located in the RC Zoning District at 51 West Middlesex Drive, Cumberland County tax parcel no. 21-14-0867-039.

PMRS – 2020 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO): On the motion of Vice - Chairman Larson, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to approve the PMRS Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for the Middlesex Township Police Pension Plan (21-039-5 P) as submitted to PMRS.

On the motion of Vice - Chairman Larson, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to approve the PMRS Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for the Middlesex Township Non-Uniform Pension Plan (21-039-5 N) as submitted to PMRS.

Authorization to sell the 1988 Trail King Trailer: On the motion of Vice – Chairman Larson, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to authorize the Director of Public Safety to sell on Municibid, the 1988 Trail King Trailer.

Zoning Officer Mr. Carpenter reported that Mr. George Costopoulos had been in previously to discuss changing to the zoning to allow storage units at 3101 Spring Road, Carlisle. Mr. Costopoulos is applying for a hearing before the Zoning Hearing Board to request a special exception to develop the subject property within RC district at 3101 Spring Road and to request a variance to increase the building coverage allowance, to increase impervious coverage allowance and to decrease the side yard requirement.

On the motion of Vice – Chairman Larson, seconded by Supervisor Goodhart, it was unanimously agreed to support the application submitted by Mr. George Costopoulos requesting a special exception and variances for the property located at 3101 Spring Road, Carlisle.
