CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG – Vice Chairman Chuck Shughart called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM at the Middlesex Township Building with Tiffany Pakkula leading the pledge to the flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES - Mr. Stabile made a motion to approve the minutes of August 7. Mr. Shughart seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT – None

REPORTS

SOLICITOR: Mr. Brenneman reported that the County Comprehensive Plan will be drafted by the end of October or beginning of November. There will be a series of public meetings if no major changes are made it should be adopted by March. Mr. Stabile commented that the Township needs to get their comprehensive plan finished as soon as possible.

ENGINEER: Mr. Stabile stated that Mr. Grove is still working on the future feasibility of sewer and water or at least reserve that area for future zoning as part of the Comprehensive Plan. Mr. Carpenter still has mapping to work on with Gannett Fleming.

POLICE: Ordered to file.

ZONING OFFICER: Ordered to file. Mr. Stabile asked if Mr. Carpenter has a feel for the number of permits issued this year. Mr. Carpenter reported that Mr. Reiff has been working

on getting a HOP for a new driveway and he is getting an engineer to help with the variance, rezoning, and a land development plan. Mr. Stabile recommended keeping this on the agenda in the future.

RECREATION: Ordered to file. The park times have changed from dawn to 10 PM to dawn to dusk. Mr. Robert Snyder gave the Senior Citizen Report.

FIRE/EMC: Ordered to file.

MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY: No report

SECRETARY: Mr. Justh reported that she had again contacted the Susquehanna River Basin Organization about the signage for the Letort Stream and they still insisted that the proper paperwork needed to be filed. The Supervisors had previously decided that Secretary Justh should not sign indemnification papers to have the Letort Spring signage placed in the Township, so Mrs. Justh asked the Susquehanna River Basin to take Middlesex Township off the their list.

OLD BUSINESS

ABF Freight Systems Inc. Developers Agreement – Mr. Brenneman reported that he is expecting to get a draft of comments from Mr. Ron Lucas for the workshop meeting on the 27th of September. Mr. Shughart is still concerned about the number of dock doors that they will be operating with. Mr. Stabile asked what the date is for the plan to be approved. Mr. Carpenter reported that it is the end of the year.

Silver Spring Township/Bill Cook – Adding North to Old Stone House Road – Mr. Cook from Silver Spring contacted Mrs. Justh concerning the Supervisor's decision on how to correct the problem of numbering or adding directional signs on Old Stone House Road. A brief discussion followed with the Supervisors agreeing to attend a Silver Spring Supervisors Meeting to try to correct the numbering on the road. The Supervisors suggested that a letter be send to Monroe Township asking them to help make the signage on Old Stone House Road more clear, by possibly renumbering the entire length of the road in all three townships.

NEW BUSINESS

Chief Sherman asked to advertise for **sale a 1994 Crown Victoria and 1984 Chevrolet Pickup Truck S-10**. Mr. Stabile made a motion to advertise for sale the 1994 Crown Victoria and 1984 Chevrolet Pickup Truck S-10 with bids being opened on September 27th at the Workshop Meeting. Mr. Shughart seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Chief Sherman told the Supervisors that he has scheduled a meeting with the businesses and **Labor and Industry for October 23 at 1:00 PM** at the Township Building concerning the Car Show.
