Review of the 2023 Draft Budget: The proposed 2023 Draft Budget was presented to the Board of Supervisors with a tax increase from .00176 mills to .00226 mills. The last tax increase was in 2019. One of the reasons the increase was necessary because of the loss of revenue from the removal of the American Rescue Plan Funds and the MS4 fees that had not been implemented. Also, as the Township continues to grow, there will be a need to hire more staff in order to provide the services needed for the community. After much discussion, the Supervisors were pleased with the balanced budget and how it was presented. The staff was commended for their hard work on the budget.
