The duly advertised special meeting was called to order at 2:30 PM in the Middlesex Township Municipal Building by Chairman Robert Eppley.

The Supervisors worked on employee salary and benefits projection for the 1999 budget.

The Supervisors decided unanimously not to increase Township contributions to outside agencies for the 1999 budget.

Mr. Capuano made a motion for Chief Sherman to get bids on a small truck to be used to plow Township roads. Mr. Shughart seconded and it passed unanimously. The Supervisors gave Chief Sherman permission to price a set scales used in weighting tractor trailers.

The Board of Supervisors agreed unanimously to appropriate the excess interest from PMRS to the individual accounts based on individual's credited service.

Mrs. Justh explained to the Supervisors how the 902 and 904 grants for Solid Waste and Recycling may affect the way we write and advertise our Recycling Ordinance. The suggestion was made to contact Solicitor Brenneman concerning the wording in the Ordinance. The Supervisors agreed that any money generated by a Township-wide Hauling and Recycling Ordinance with respect to the 904 grant and businesses in the Township should go into the General Fund.

The meeting was recessed at 4:05 PM.
