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The meeting was called to order by Chairman Robert Eppley at 7:31 AM in the Middlesex Township Building.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

GREENWAY AND OPEN SPACE COORDINATOR – Stephanie Williams of Cumberland County Planning gave a brief presentation on the water trail under way through Cumberland County Greenway Project. She explained to the Supervisors that the trail will be based on the Conodoquinet Creek through Middlesex Township from North Middleton Township to the Susquehanna River. Williams stated that there are no access points in Middlesex Township except at the Appalachian Trail Offices. Printing for the brochures in connection with the trail will be provided by Greenway funding through Cumberland County Planning. Ms. Williams explained that the stream may not be navigable at all times of the year, but the Army Corp of Engineers has deemed that it is still accessible for the purpose of a water trail.

FLYING “J” INCIDNET OF CONCERN – Mrs. Justh reported that Mr. Stabile had requested this item be placed on the agenda.

GP ORDINANCE CONSULTANT REPORT – Mr. Grove reported that the report was not quite ready, but will be ready for the November 7th meeting.

(#02-11) RITNER STEEL PRELIMINARY/FINAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN – Mr. Frank Lentz presented the plan to the Supervisors. Mr. Grove stated that changes were made to the drawing and the Planning Commission needs to review this again, and it will be ready for the November 7th meeting.

Mr. Brenneman asked Mrs. Justh to call PSATS and check if they have a sample of the **Right-to-know Act** policy statement that we could use for Middlesex. New amendments to the law will be effective mid December, 2002 and require the adoption of a policy by municipalities.

Mr. Eppley asked Mr. Carpenter to check on the **Rent-A-Wreck** over on Trindle Road with respect to the number of cars parked on the front of the property.

Mr. Shughart thought that there should not be any discussion on the **budget** at this time, we will wait until next month.

Execute Session

The Supervisors came back from executive session and Chief Sherman asked the Supervisors to consider an Ordinance to post **no parking signs on Country Club Road** between US route 11 to Circle Drive. Mr. Shughart made a motion to have Mr. Brenneman draft and advertise an Ordinance to post no parking signs on County Club Road between US route 11 to the south entrance of Circle Drive to be ready to enact at the Supervisors meeting on December 4th. Mr. Eppley seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
