The duly advertised special meeting was called to order at 2 PM in the Middlesex Township Municipal Building by Chairman Robert Eppley.

Paul Rodgers was present representing the All-American affiliates and questioned the amount of his group's assessment. After a discussion of Mr. Rodger's concerns, Mr. Capuano moved to approve Ordinance 11-97, establishing a street light district within the Township and providing for the payment of the costs of said lighting through uniform annual assessments. Motion seconded by Mr. Shughart and passed unanimously. Mr. Capuano then introduced Resolution 97-17, establishing the foot frontage assessment for street lighting for 1998. The resolution was seconded by Mr. Shughart and passed unanimously.

Next, on a motion by Mr. Capuano which was seconded by Mr. Shughart and passed unanimously, the Board approved Ordinance 12-97, amending the Middlesex Township Zoning Ordinance by amending the zoning map to reduce a portion of the Residential-Suburban District and to replace said area by Village-Center Zoning District.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:30 PM.
