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The meeting was called to order by Chairman Robert Eppley at 7:38 AM in the Middlesex Township Building.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Mr. Mel Spahr a Township resident approached the Board of Supervisors asking to be exonerated for the yearly \$45.00 fee for trash hauling through York Waste. Mr. Stabile asked if Mr. Spahr knew of others that were in the same circumstances. Mr. Brenneman stated that you can charge someone even if they do not use the service. Mrs. Justh asked about burning paper and not complying with the Burning Ordinance. Mr. Stabile explained that Trash Hauling will be going out for bid next year and maybe this is an area we need to look at.

(#01-17) FAULKNER COLLISION CENTER OF CARLISLE PRELIMINARY/FINAL SUBDIVISION PLAN PRELIMINARY/FINAL LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN – Eric Schroeder from J Michael Brill & Assoc. represented the Faulkner Collision Plan. Comments have been addressed from the County, Authority and the Township all except one. Mr. Grove stated the Faulkner needs to go ahead with the E & S Plan regardless of the problem with the drainage swale. Mr. Grove stated that he had no problem with approving the plan. Mr. Grove stated that he needs to collect as much information as possible to make a recommendation to improve the way the swale was built. Mr. Stabile is concerned with the lighting at **Pyrotek**. Mr. Carpenter has been in conversation with the owner concerning the wall packs trying to correct the glare coming from those lights. Mr. Shughart asked about wrecked vehicle storage. Mr. Grove and Mr. Carpenter stated that the vehicles will be parked in the rear of the building. The Supervisors asked that an area be designated for wrecked vehicles. Mr. Stabile asked about the building enlargement that is indicated on the plan. Mr. Grove indicated that he has considered any additions that are indicated on the plan. Mr. Carpenter stated that when they are ready to expand they can do that with only a building permit.

GROUNDWATER PROTECTION ORDINANCE – Mr. Stabile gave his comments on what has been done to the Groundwater Protection Ordinance and stated what changes should be considered and incorporated into the Ordinance for review at the next Supervisors Meeting on December 5th.

GRASS/WEED VEGETATION ORDINANCE – Mr. Stabile explained that the only thing that was still a problem was what is prohibited and what was exempted. Mr. Brenneman will have a corrected version for the next meeting.

ARMY MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING – Mr. Shughart made a motion to change the MOU to have Mr. Stabile replace Mr. Eppley as the contact person for the Army Heritage Center and execute the MOU. Mr. Eppley seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Stabile asked Mrs. Justh if there was anything needed for the budget. Mrs. Justh stated that she has a revised resolution for review at the December 5 meeting.

Mr. Eppley reminded everyone that the Tree Lighting was tonight.

Mr. Grove asked what his responsibilities are with respect to Roadway Drive Drainage Problem.

Mrs. Justh asked what the time frame was for changing Claremont Drive to Army Heritage Drive. Mr. Stabile asked Mr. Carpenter to contact Perry. Mr. Stabile said that since the barracks are still there we should go ahead and change to the name.
