ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 1986

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF
CERTAIN PORTIONS OF PUBLIC ROADS AT ALL TIMES
(CLINTON DRIVE; PENNSYLVANIA ROUTE NO. 34, SPRING
ROAD; BERNHISEL BRIDGE ROAD; HARRISBURG PIKE, U.S.
ROUTE NO. 11), PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SIGNS
AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex is a Local Authority under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81, as amended [75 Pa. C.S.A. 101 et seq.]) having certain roads or highways and functions under its jurisdiction, including the regulation of stopping and parking on township and state highways [See Section 6109 of said Code]; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex has conducted all necessary engineering and traffic investigation incidental to its exercise of its authority hereunder; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex deems it in the best interest of its residents and the users of certain roads and highways within said Township to prohibit parking of vehicles on certain roads and highways;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: PREAMBLE AND POLICY

The foregoing paragraphs or preamble are incorporated herein as the background and policy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

Words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings

ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended, except that in this Ordinance the word "road" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway" and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 3: PARKING AND/OR STOPPING OF VEHICLES PROHIBITED ON
CERTAIN ROADS AND HIGHWAYS AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to park or stop a motor vehicle at any time on either side and on both sides of the following roads or portions thereof:

(1) Clinton Drive: throughout its entire length from Harrisburg Pike (U.S. Route 11) to South Letort Drive.

(2) Spring Road (Pennsylvania Route No. 34): for a distance of 700 feet into this Township from the municipal boundary line between Middlesex and North Middleton Townships.

(3) Bernhisel Bridge Road:

(A) for a distance of 550 feet south of the southern end of the bridge over the Conodoguinet Creek.

(b) for a distance of 600 feet north of the northern end of the bridge over the Conodoguinet Creek.

(C) throughout the entire length of the bridge over the Conodoguinet Creek.

(4) Harrisburg Pike (U.S. Route No. 11): from the eastern line of the intersection with Country Club Road to the municipal boundary line between Middlesex and Silver Spring Townships.

(b) Appropriate signs shall be posted along said roads and highways indicating the prohibition against parking and/or stopping.

(c) Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall, upon conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is declared to be the legislative intention that this Ordinance would have been enacted had the unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid provisions not been included in the Ordinance.

SECTION 5: CONTINUATION OF EXISTING REGULATIONS

The provisions of this Ordinance insofar as they are the same as those of ordinances and regulations in force immediately before the enactment of this Ordinance are intended as a continuation of those earlier ordinances and regulations. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect any act done or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any earlier ordinances or regulations repealed or superseded hereby.

SECTION 6: REPEAL OF CERTAIN PRIOR ORDINANCES

All prior ordinances of this Township insofar as they deal with the precise subject matter of this Ordinance are repealed and declared to be unenforceable insofar as they are inconsistent with any

provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.
