ORDINANCE NO. / -93

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND/OR CONFIRMING
STOP INTERSECTIONS FOR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AT
VARIOUS INTERSECTIONS OF EXISTING PUBLIC
STREETS AND ROADS AND OTHER STREETS, ROADS
OR DRIVES ACCESSING UPON PUBLIC STREETS AND
ROADS; PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SIGNS;
AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF
THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex is a Local Authority
under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L.
162, No. 81, as amended [75 Pa. C.S.A. 101 et seq.]) having
certain roads or highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, said Township of Middlesex deemed it in the best
interest of its residents and the users of said roads or
highways to establish and to control intersections of certain
public streets and roads and intersections of other streets,
roads or drives accessing upon public streets and roads by "stop
signs";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is
hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors
in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County,
Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1: PREAMBLE AND POLICY

The foregoing paragraphs or preamble are incorporated
herein as the background and policy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

Words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended, except that in this Ordinance the word "road" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway" and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 3: STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

(a) The intersections of the following "stop highways" (which include public streets and roads, and other streets, roads or driveways accessing upon public streets and roads) with the indicated "through highways" in Middlesex Township are hereby established as stop intersections, and official stop signs shall be erected within the legal rights-of-way of the following "stop highways" facing the traffic approaching the "through highways" at controlled intersections on the several "stop highways":

(b) Every driver of a vehicle approaching the above mentioned intersections on the "stop highway" in the direction indicated in each case in subsection (a) shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code and shall not proceed into, through or across any said intersection of streets until he has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the Code.

(c) Any person who violates any provisions of this Section, shall, upon conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is declared to be the legislative intention that this Ordinance would have been enacted had the unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid provisions not been included in the Ordinance.

SECTION 5: CONTINUATION OF EXISTING REGULATIONS

The provisions of this Ordinance insofar as they are the same as those of ordinances and regulations in force immediately before the enactment of this Ordinance are intended as a continuation of those earlier ordinances and regulations. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect any act done or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any earlier ordinances or regulations repealed or superseded hereby.

SECTION 6: REPEAL OF CERTAIN PRIOR ORDINANCES

All prior ordinances of this Township insofar as they deal with the precise subject matter of this Ordinance are repealed and declared to be unenforceable insofar as they are inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.
