AN ORDINANCE OF AND BY THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS IN AND FOR MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ITS "MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP SMALL FLOW SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY ORDINANCE" (ORDINANCE NO. 2-95) BY ADDING THE DEFINITION OF "TOWNSHIP ENGINEER", DELETING VARIOUS RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER ("S.E.O.") AND SUBSTITUTING THE TOWNSHIP ENGINEER THEREFOR.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 2-95 enacted on March 31, 1995, known as "Middlesex Township Small Flow Sewage Treatment Facility Ordinance" is hereby amended in the following respects:

A. Section 3 of said Ordinance is amended by adding thereto the following definition:

"Township Engineer": the township engineer as regularly appointed from time to time by the Board pursuant to the Second Class Township Code.

B. The references to S.E.O. (Sewage Enforcement Officer) in the following sections of said Ordinance are deleted: Section 5; Subsection A(6) of Section 13; and Subsection B of Section 13.

C. The Township Engineer is hereby substituted for the S.E.O. in each deleted place stated in subparagraph B immediately above, and in each such

place, the Township Engineer shall have the power, duty and responsibility formerly assigned to the S.E.O.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with prevailing law.
