

ORDINANCE NO. 2-64, 1964

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING OWNERS, CUSTODIANS AND KEEPERS OF DOGS, LICENSED AND UNLICENSED, FROM ALLOWING SUCH DOGS TO RUN AT LARGE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for the owner, custodian or keeper of any dog, licensed or unlicensed, to allow such dog to run at large at any time, either upon any of the streets, roads, alleys or public grounds in the Township of Middlesex, or upon the property of one other than the owner, custodian or keeper of such dog, unless accompanied by and under the immediate control of such owner, custodian or keeper.

SECTION 2: Any owner, custodian or keeper of any dog who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, be liable upon conviction thereof, before any Justice of the Peace in a summary proceeding to pay a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of such fine and costs, to undergo imprisonment in the Cumberland County Jail for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION 3: If any section or part of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any other part of this Ordinance; it is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been enacted had such invalid section, or portion of a section, not have been included herein.

SECTION 4: Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances inconsistent

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with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.
