

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 1986

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF CERTAIN ROADS
AND HIGHWAYS BY TRUCKS, EXCEPT FOR LOCAL DELIVERIES
(STOVER DRIVE, NORTH DRIVE, SOUTH LETORT DRIVE
AND MILL ROAD), PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SIGNS,
AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex is a Local Authority under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Uode (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended [75 Pa. C.S.A. 101 et seq.]) having certain roads or highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, said Township of Middlesex has conducted all necessary engineering and traffic investigation incidental to its exercise of authority hereunder; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex deems it in the best interest of its residents and the users of certain roads and highways within said Township to prohibit the use of certain roads and highways as thoroughfares for trucks except only for local deliveries on said roads and highways;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: PREAMBLE AND POLICY

The foregoing paragraphs or preamble are incorporated herein as the background and policy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

Words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, Ho. 81), as amended, except that in this Ordinance the word "road" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway" and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 3: TRUCK TRAFFIC PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN ROADS AND HIGHWAYS AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle other than a passenger car on any of the following roads or highways:

(1) Stover Drive: throughout its entire length between its two intersections with Claremont Road;

(2) North Letort Drive: throughout its entire length between Harrisburg Pike (U.S. Route 11) and South Letort Drive;

(3) South Letort Drive: throughout its entire length between North Letort Drive and Clinton Drive;

(4) Mill Road: throughout its entire length between Harrisburg Pike (U.S. Route 11) and North Middlesex Road;

Provided, however, that nothing in this section shall prohibit any person from driving an emergency vehicle on any of said roads

or highways, or from driving on said roads or highways a truck or other commercial vehicle for the exclusive purpose of making local deliveries to or pickups from premises located along said roads or highways.

(b) Appropriate signs shall be posted at the entrances to said roads or highways indicating the prohibition of use by trucks or other commercial vehicles.

(c) Any person who violates any provision of this Section shall upon conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is declared to be the legislative intention that this Ordinance would have been enacted had the unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid provisions not been included in the Ordinance.

SECTION 5: CONTINUATION OF EXISTING REGULATIONS

The provisions of this Ordinance insofar as they are the same as those of ordinances and regulations in force immediately before the enactment of this Ordinance are intended as a continuation of those earlier ordinances and regulations. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect any act done or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any earlier ordinances or regulations repealed or

superseded hereby.

SECTION 6: REPEAL OF CERTAIN PRIOR ORDINANCES

All prior ordinances of this Township insofar as they deal with the precise subject matter of this Ordinance are repealed and declared to be unenforceable insofar as they are inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance.

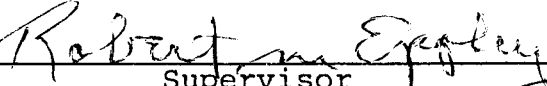
SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE

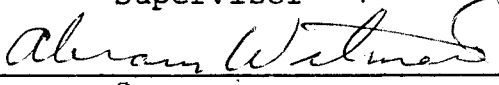
This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.

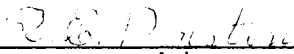
