

ORDINANCE NO. 90-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX,  
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING  
SECTION 12.03 OF THE MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP  
ZONING ORDINANCE ENACTED JUNE 30, 1989, BY  
DELETING PROHIBITIONS AGAINST THE USES OF  
RENDERING, SLAUGHTERING OR TANNING PLANTS  
AND BY ADDING PROCESSING OF ANIMAL HIDES AS  
A PERMITTED USE.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted  
and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the  
Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as  
follows:

SECTION 1: Section 12.03 in Article XII of the Middlesex  
Township Zoning Ordinance as originally enacted on June 30,  
1989, is hereby amended.

(a) By deleting from Subsection A.1.1. the  
words "but not including rendering, slaughtering or  
tanning plants", so that said subsection A.1.1. shall  
hereafter read:

1. Agricultural, food and kindred  
products.

(b) By adding thereto a new Subsection G as  
follows:

- G. Skinning of dead animals and  
processing the hides.

SECTION 2: Except only as amended, modified and changed  
by the present Ordinance, the Middlesex Township Zoning Ordinance  
shall remain in all other respects in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.
