ORDINANCE NO. 2-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6-66 TO
PROVIDE FOR A PLANNING COMMISSION CONSISTING
OF EIGHT MEMBERS

WHEREAS, a planning commission for Middlesex Township (the "Township") was established pursuant to Middlesex Township Ordinance No. 6-66; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code allows an increase in the number of members of an existing planning commission by ordinance of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Township and owners of property within the Township to increase the number of members of the Planning Commission to eight in order to allow and provide for additional input and more diversity of views in the performance of the functions of the Middlesex Township Planning Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing Preamble is incorporated herein in its entirety by reference thereto.

SECTION 2: The Middlesex Township Planning Commission shall consist of eight (8) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors, which members shall meet all applicable requirements for membership and serve for such terms as established from time to time by applicable law.

SECTION 3: In all other respects, Middlesex Township Ordinance No. 6-66 to the extent consistent with the enabling legislation of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with existing law.
