ORDINANCE 2-2003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
IN AND FOR MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2-93 AND REPEALING
A PORTION OF SECTION 2 THEREOF.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2-93, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township established the compensation for the Township Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2-93 limited the total amount of compensation to the Township Tax Collector to an amount less than that otherwise permitted by the Local Tax Collection Law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township desire to remove the compensation limitation imposed by ordinance 2-93.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 2-93 is hereby amended by deleting and repealing from Section 2 thereof the following language:

The sum of the above amounts of compensation shall not exceed Seven Thousand Two Hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$7,200.00) per annum.

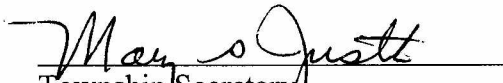

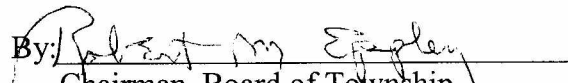
SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be considered effective and applicable to compensation of the Township Tax Collector beginning in the fiscal year 2000.

CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING
THE COMPENSATION OF THE MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP
TAX COLLECTOR HEREAFTER ELECTED OR APPOINTED.

ORDINANCE 2-93

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex situate in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, is a Township of the Second Class and is governed by The Second Class Township Code, which Code provides for the office and position of Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, the Local Tax Collection Law requires the Board of Township Supervisors to establish the compensation of the Township Tax Collector for the collection of Township taxes prior to the election or appointment of said Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex intends hereby to establish the compensation of the Township Tax Collector hereafter elected or appointed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. PREAMBLE, AUTHORITY AND POLICY.

The foregoing paragraphs or preambles are incorporated herein as the background, authority and policy of and for this ordinance.

SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF COMPENSATION OF TAX COLLECTOR.

The compensation of the Tax Collector in, for and of the Township of Middlesex hereafter elected or appointed shall be the sum of the amounts in Paragraphs A, B, C, D, and E herein below, subject, however, to the limitation hereinafter set forth:

A. A sum of money not to exceed two and one-half per centum (2.5%) of the first \$200,000.00 of the total of Middlesex Township real estate and personal taxes actually collected by the Tax Collector at the discount and face or normal rates.

B. A sum of money equal to one-half of one per centum (1/2%) of all Middlesex Township real estate and personal taxes in excess of the first \$200,000.00 mentioned above actually collected by the Tax Collector at the discount and face or normal rates.

C. A sum of money not to exceed five per centum (5%) of the first \$25,000.00 of the total of Middlesex Township real estate and personal taxes actually collected by the Tax Collector at the penalty rate.

D. A sum of money equal to one-half of one per centum (1/2%) of all Middlesex Township real estate and personal taxes in excess of the first \$25,000.00 mentioned above actually collected by the Tax Collector at the penalty rate.

E. Ten cents (\$0.10) per Tax Bill of (1) uncollected Middlesex Township real estate taxes returned to the Cumberland County Tax Claim Bureau, and (2) uncollected Middlesex Township personal taxes submitted to a delinquent collector or as exonerated by the Board of Township Supervisors.

The sum of the above amounts of compensation shall not exceed Seven Thousand Two Hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$7,200.00) per annum.

SECTION 3. APPLICATION.

The foregoing compensation shall be applicable to all tax collections occurring on and after January 1, 1994, and to all tax collectors elected or appointed after the enactment of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

This ordinance shall not affect, change or modify the compensation of the Tax Collector for the calendar year 1993.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.
