

ORDINANCE NO. 90-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
SECTION 2.03 OF THE MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP
ZONING ORDINANCE ENACTED JUNE 30, 1989, AS
SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED, BY AMENDING THE
DEFINITION OF "IMPERVIOUS AREA" TO INCLUDE
PARKING LOTS AND PARKING AREAS REGARDLESS OF
THE DEGREE OF PRECIPITATION PENETRABILITY.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted
and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the
Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as
follows:

SECTION 1: The definition of "Impervious Area" as
contained in Section 2.03 in Article II of the Middlesex Township
Zoning Ordinance as originally enacted on June 30, 1989, as
subsequently amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
following underlined provisions:

Impervious Area: Any portion of a lot covered by
material impenetrable by precipitation, including
buildings, structures, parking lots, parking areas
and paved areas. For the purposes of this definition,
all portions of parking lots and parking areas shall
be considered as impervious area regardless of the
degree of precipitation penetrability.

SECTION 2: Except only as amended, modified and changed
by the present Ordinance, the Middlesex Township Zoning Ordinance
shall remain in all other respects in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective in
accordance with applicable law.
