ORDINANCE NO. 3 - 2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 75-1 BY REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS BY APPLICANTS FOR A PEDDLING OR SOLICITING LICENSES.

WHEREAS, Middlesex Township by Ordinance 75-1 established certain regulations, requirements and license fees with respect to the peddling and soliciting within the Township of Middlesex; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township desired to amend Ordinance 75-1 to require applicants for a peddling or soliciting license to submit, at the applicant's expense, a criminal background check record as part of the application process.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1.

The foregoing preamble is incorporated herein in its entirety by reference thereto.

SECTION 2.

Section 5: Application for license of Ordinance 75-1 is hereby changed and amended to include the following additional language at the end of Paragraph A thereof:

All applications shall be accompanied by a copy of a criminal background check obtained from the Pennsylvania Access to Criminal History website, located at <https://epatch.state.pa.us/Home.jsp> (or any successor website location designated by the state or Pennsylvania State Police for obtaining such criminal background history) for

each person that makes an application and for each application form completed for each helper. The cost of the criminal history records check report shall be borne in all cases by the person making such application.

SECTION 3.

The first paragraph of Section 6: Investigation and Issuance of License of Ordinance 75-1 is hereby changed and amended to provide in its entirety as follows:

Upon submission of a complete application, a copy of a criminal background check and payment of the application fee, provided the applicant or helper for whom an application has been submitted does not have a criminal history, a license shall be issued by the Secretary or Police Department. No license will be issued to an applicant or for a helper who has a criminal record.

SECTION 4.

Except as specifically modified by this Ordinance, Middlesex Township Ordinance 75-1 and 06-4 shall remain in full force and effect.

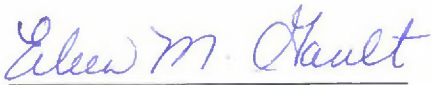
SECTION 5.

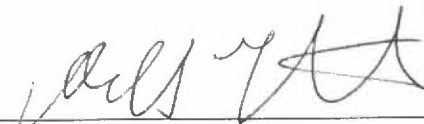
This Ordinance shall be effective in accordance with existing law.
