ORDINANCE NO. 4 -06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 75-1 BY CHANGING PEDDLING AND SOLICITING PERMIT FEES AND ALLOWING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SUCH FEES BY RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, Middlesex Township by Ordinance 75-1 established certain regulations, requirements and license fees with respect to the activity of peddling and soliciting within the Township of Middlesex; and

WHEREAS, the permit fees established in 1975 have not been changed or increased and do not adequately represent the cost to Middlesex Township to administer the licenses, the number of which have increased significantly since enactment of Ordinance 75-1.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing Preamble is incorporated herein in its entirety by reference thereto.

SECTION 2: Section 7: Fees of Ordinance 75-1 is hereby changed and amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

The fee required to be paid with the application is \$50.00 for a one-week license and \$100.00 for a one-year license. Fees shall be deposited in the general fund of the Township and shall not be refunded if the application is refused or the license revoked prior to expiration.

The license fees established by this Ordinance or any amendment thereto may be changed, reduced or increased from time to time by the Board of Supervisors by Resolution duly enacted.

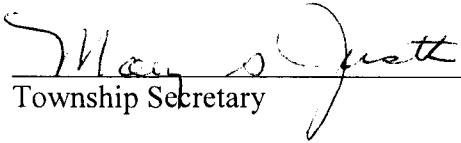
SECTION 3: Except as specifically modified hereby, Middlesex Township Ordinance No. 75-1 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with existing law.
