ORDINANCE NO. 5-98

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING CONRAD DRIVE OR ROAD
(T-410) TO PASSENGER VEHICLES, PROVIDING FOR
THE ERECTION OF SIGNS AND ESTABLISHING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex is a Local Authority under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended [75 Pa.C.S.A. 101, et seq.] having certain roads or highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, said Township of Middlesex has conducted all necessary engineering and traffic investigation incidental to its exercise of authority hereunder; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex deems it in the best interest of its residents and the users of Conrad Drive (sometimes referred to as Conrad Road) (T-410) to restrict the non-passenger vehicle use of Conrad Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1: PREAMBLE AND POLICY

The foregoing paragraphs or preamble are incorporated herein as the background and policy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

Words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended.

SECTION 3: RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF CONRAD DRIVE OR ROAD; PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle other than a passenger car on any part or portion of Conrad Drive or Road. Provided, however, that nothing in this Section shall prohibit any person from driving an emergency vehicle or school bus on any part or portion of Conrad Drive or Road, or from driving on any part or portion of said Conrad Drive on Road a truck or other commercial vehicle making local deliveries to or pickups from premises located along Conrad Drive or Road.

(b) Appropriate signs shall be posted noting the restrictions on the use of Conrad Drive or Road as noted above, which sign shall be posted in accordance with regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

(c) Any person who violates any provision of this Section is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 and costs of the proceeding.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is declared to be the legislative intention that this Ordinance would have been enacted had the unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid provisions not been included in this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.
