ORDINANCE NO. 5 – 2008

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE 13-2007 WITH RESPECT TO THE TIME PERIOD DURING WHICH OUTDOOR WOOD-FIRED BOILERS MAY BE UTILIZED.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 7, paragraph i of Ordinance 13-2007 is hereby amended to provide in its entirety as follows:

- i. Use shall be limited to seven (7) days after the Labor Day holiday to seven (7) days before the Memorial Day holiday.

SECTION 2: Except as only specifically modified herein, Ordinance 13-2007 as previously amended shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or of Ordinance 13-2007 as amended or any part or portion thereof.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with applicable law.

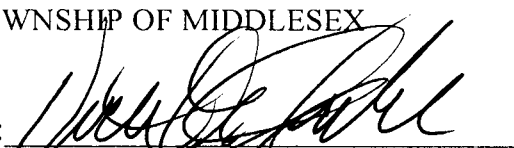
