ORDINANCE NO. 6-98

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS
AT THE INTERSECTION OF HARMONY HALL DRIVE
(T-420) AND THE DRIVEWAY SERVICING THE PROPERTY
NOW COMMONLY KNOWN AS 1099 HARRISBURG PIKE AND
WOLFS BRIDGE ROAD (T-508) AND THE DRIVEWAY
SERVICING THE PROPERTY NOW COMMONLY KNOWN AS 1098
HARRISBURG PIKE, CARLISLE, PROVIDING FOR THE
ERECTION OF SIGNS AND ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR
THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex is a Local Authority
under the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L.
162, No. 81), as amended [75 Pa.C.S.A. 101, et seq.] having
certain roads or highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, said Township of Middlesex has conducted all
necessary engineering and traffic investigations incidental to
its exercise of authority hereunder; and

WHEREAS, said Township of Middlesex deems it in the best
interest of its residents and the users of Harmony Hall Drive and
Wolfs Bridge Road to require that certain driveway or points of
access to said roadways have traffic control in order to promote
safety to vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, said Township of Middlesex deems it in the best
interest of its residents and the users of said roads or highways
to control intersections by "stop signs";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby
enacted and ordained by the Board of Township Supervisors in and
for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as

follows:

SECTION 1: PREAMBLE AND POLICY

The foregoing paragraphs or preamble are incorporated herein as the background and policy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

Words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81), as amended, except that in this Ordinance the word "road" may be used interchangeably with the word "highway" and shall have the same meaning as the word "highway" as defined in the Vehicle Code.

SECTION 3: STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

(a) The intersection of the driveway or access servicing the property commonly known as 1099 Harrisburg Pike, Carlisle, (which property is located at the southwest corner of the intersection of U. S. Route 11 and Harmony Hall Drive) and Harmony Hall Drive (T-420), a public township road, is hereby established as a stop intersection, at which an official stop sign ("sign") shall be erected within the legal right-of-way limits of the road and positioned on the south side of said driveway to stop traffic approaching Harmony Hall Drive from the west.

(b) The intersection of the driveway or access servicing the property commonly known as 1098 Harrisburg

Pike, Carlisle, (which property is located at the northwest corner of the intersection of U. S. Route 11 and Wolfs Bridge Road) and Wolfs Bridge Road (T-508), a public township road, is hereby established as a stop intersection, at which an official stop sign ("sign") shall be erected within the legal right-of-way limits of the road and positioned on the south side of said driveway to stop traffic approaching Wolfs Bridge Road from the west.

(c) Every driver of a vehicle approaching the above mentioned intersections in the direction indicated in subsections (a) or (b) shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code and shall not proceed into, through or across said intersection of streets or roads until he/she has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the Code.

(d) Any person who violates any provision of this Section, is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25.00 and costs of the proceeding.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. It is declared to be the legislative intention that this Ordinance would have been enacted had the unconstitutional,

illegal or otherwise invalid provisions not been included in this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.
