ORDINANCE NO. 84-7

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, GRANTING TO THE MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY CERTAIN RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES IN, ALONG, OVER AND UNDER STREETS, ROADS, LANES, COURTS, CUL-DE-SACS, ALLEYS, PUBLIC WAYS, PUBLIC SQUARES AND OTHER PROPERTIES OF THIS TOWNSHIP FOR USE IN CONNECTION WITH SAID AUTHORITY'S WATER SYSTEM; AND PROVIDING FOR REGULATING THE MANNER IN WHICH SUCH RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES SHALL BE EXERCISED.

WHEREAS, Middlesex Township Municipal Authority (the "Authority"), pursuant to authority vested in it by law, plans to construct and to acquire certain water transmission and distribution system facilities required for rendering water service in, to and for portions of this Township, which facilities collectively are referred to herein as the "Water System".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Middlesex, as follows:

SECTION 1. This Township does grant to the Authority, its successors and assigns, all easements, rights of way and other rights and privileges necessary and desirable in, along, over and under streets, roads, lanes, courts, cul-de-sacs, alleys, public ways, public squares and other properties of this Township, all being located in or about the area of this Township, together with free ingress, egress and regress therein and thereto, along with other persons having interests or rights therein, for use in connection with

constructing, replacing, repairing, altering, extending, improving, operating and maintaining the Water System as the same shall exist, from time to time.

SECTION 2. The rights and privileges granted to the Authority under Section 1 shall be exercised by the Authority under and subject to such reasonable rules and regulations as shall be adopted and specified, from time to time, by resolution or ordinance of this Township; and this Township does reserve the right to adopt and specify, from time to time, such reasonable rules and regulations in connection with exercise by the Authority of such rights and privileges.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.

SECTION 4. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intent of this Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.
