ORDINANCE NO. 9-91

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS IN AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF
MIDDLESEX, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF TOWNSHIP
SUPERVISORS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ACT OF
ASSEMBLY NO. 41 OF MARCH 30, AMENDING SECTION
515 OF THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE

WHEREAS, the Township of Middlesex is a Township of the
Second Class located in Cumberland County, having a population
of 5,773 based upon the 1990 Federal census; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of
Pennsylvania by Act approved by the Governor on March 30, 1988,
(known as P.L. 312 Act No. 41) duly amended the Second Class
Township Code authorizing the fixing of compensation for
Township Supervisors, in accordance with a scale based upon
township population; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Supervisors of said Township
of Middlesex desires to implement the provisions of said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by
the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of
Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Each Township Supervisor of the Township of
Middlesex shall receive compensation as such Supervisor in the
annual amount of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars.

SECTION 2: The compensation fixed by Section 1 above shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1992.
