

ORDINANCE NO. 10-69

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SANITARY
LANDFILLS OR OTHER WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITIES UPON ANY
ROAD OR PIECE OF GROUND WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX
AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE SAME.**

Be It and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board
of Supervisors of Middlesex Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1. No person, association, firm or corporation shall keep, place or suffer to remain upon his, her or its premises, or on any private or public property in the Township of Middlesex any facility for waste disposal of any kind whatsoever or any sanitary landfills for the disposing of any waste materials of any kind whatsoever. Nor may any person, firm or corporation use or permit to be used any spot, ground, location or place within the Township of Middlesex as a public or private dump or sanitary landfill for the disposal of waste, refuse, garbage, rubbish or debris whatsoever.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than One hundred (\$100.00) dollars and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days. Provided: each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. Severability - If any of the provisions of this ordinance should be declared to be invalid, the other provisions hereof shall remain valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

FINALLY PASSED and enacted as an ordinance of the Township of Middlesex at a meeting of the Board of Supervisors held the second day of April, 1969.
