ORDINANCE NO. 10-97

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING
RAYSTAY CO., D/B/A TV CABLE OF CARLISLE, TO
UTILIZE CERTAIN PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY WITHIN
THE TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING
CABLE TELEVISION SERVICE, AND ASSESSING A
FRANCHISE FEE AGAINST RAYSTAY CO. IN
CONSIDERATION OF SUCH USE.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted
by the Board of Township Supervisors for the Township of
Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION OF USE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY

Raystay Co., doing business as TV Cable of Carlisle, a
Pennsylvania corporation, is hereby authorized to utilize public
rights-of-way within the Township of Middlesex for purposes of
providing cable television service, in accordance with and
subject to all of the terms, provisions and limitations of a
certain Cable Television Franchise Agreement ("Agreement") dated
concurrently with the passage of this Ordinance, and any valid
extensions thereof.

SECTION 2: PAYMENT OF FRANCHISE FEE

Raystay Co. shall pay the Township of Middlesex a franchise
fee of five percent (5%) of Raystay Co.'s gross annual revenues
derived from operation of the cable communications system within

the Township of Middlesex in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Agreement and as permitted by the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 521, et seq.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with existing law.
