ORDINANCE NO. 10 -09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE MILL RATE OF TAXATION IN MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 AT 1.20 MILLS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF TEN PERCENT (10%) IN THE CASE OF TAXPAYERS WHO FAIL TO MAKE PAYMENT OF 2010 TOWNSHIP REAL ESTATE PROPERTY TAX AFTER FOUR (4) MONTHS OF THE TAX NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR A DISCOUNT OF TWO PERCENT (2%) FOR THOSE WHO MAKE PAYMENT OF SAID TAX WITHIN TWO (2) MONTHS OF NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING THE FOOT FRONTAGE ASSESSMENT FOR STREET LIGHT DISTRICT 1 FOR 2010 AT \$1.12 PER FOOT.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, as follows:

SECTION 1: A tax is hereby levied upon all real estate and all property in Middlesex Township subject to tax of said Township for the fiscal year 2010 at the rate of 1.20 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation as provided by law for general purposes of Middlesex Township. Accordingly, the rate of taxation is \$.12 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of taxable property.

SECTION 2: All tax payers required to pay the Middlesex Township real estate property tax shall be entitled to a discount of two (2) percentum from the amount of such tax upon payment of the whole amount due thereof within two (2) months after the date of the tax notice; all taxpayers who shall fail to make payment of such tax charged against them for four (4) months after the date of the tax notice shall be charged a penalty of ten (10) percentum, which

penalty shall be added to the taxes by the tax collector and shall be collected by said tax collector.

SECTION 3: The foot frontage assessment for applicable properties within Street Light District 1 shall be \$1.12 per foot for 2010.

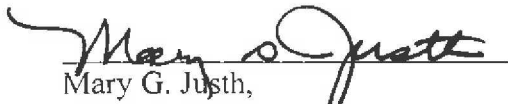
SECTION 4: All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are repealed; however, all other tax ordinances or resolutions of Middlesex Township shall remain in effect.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is enacted under the authority of the Local Tax Enabling Act and the Second Class Township Code.
