

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 12-70

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OR DUMPING OF GARBAGE AND RUBBISH, AND PROVIDING THE REMOVAL THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

SECTION 1 - That from and after the passage of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to accumulate or dump garbage or rubbish, or to permit the accumulation or dumping of garbage or rubbish, on private and public property, when the same shall constitute a nuisance or a menace to public health.

SECTION 2 - The Supervisors of Middlesex Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, shall at their discretion remove any nuisance as aforesaid, on public or private grounds after notice to the owner to do so, and in his default, to collect the cost of such removal, together with a penalty of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS and costs of prosecution from the owner by summary proceedings.

= SECTION 3 - Any firm, person or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance, where there is no removal of the aforesaid nuisance, upon conviction before any Justice of the Peace, shall be subject to a fine of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS and costs of prosecution, and in default thereof shall undergo imprisonment for a period of five (5) days. Each and every violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense with like penalties.

SECTION 4 - All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
