AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN ACTS AGAINST GOOD ORDER
AND GOVERNMENTS, HEALTH AND CLEANLINESS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP
TO BE UNLAWFUL AND PROHIBITING THE SAME.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX
TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY EN-
ACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME THAT FROM AND
AFTER PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE, IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY
PERSON, WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID TOWNSHIP, ON THE STREETS, PUB-
LIC PLACES, OR ELSEWHERE THEREIN:

= SECTION 1 - To commit a breach of the peace, or to be guilty
of vagrancy, riotous or disorderly practice, to engage in fight-
ing, assaulting, or inciting others to fight, assault, or engage
in any unlawful act tending to imperil the personal security or
endanger the property of Citizens, or the property of Companies,
Corporations, or of the Township, or others.

SECTION 2 - To use publicly profane or blasphemous language,
commit open lewdness or any act of public indecency, make any
indecent exposure of the person: to be found publicly in a state
of intoxication or drunkenness: to be gathered together in dis-
orderly assemblies on the streets or in drinking places: gamb-
ling houses, or houses of prostitution.

SECTION 3 - To make Wilfully or cause to be made loud, bois-
terous or unseemly noise or disturbance to the annoyance of the
peaceable residents nearby, more particularly between the hours
of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00A.M..

SECTION 4 - To carry wilfully concealed upon his or her per-
son any firearms, razor, dirk or bowie-knife, blackjack or hand-
billy, or any other deadly weapon.

SECTION 5 - To throw wantonly any stone, brick, or other mis-
sile, or to explode any torpedo, bomb, firecrackers or fireworks
of any kind in the streets, alleys, or highways or to raise any
false alarm of fire or other calamity.

SECTION 6 - It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly,
wilfully, enforceably to obstruct, resist, oppose or interfere
with any police officer of the Township in the performance of
his duty in serving or attempting to serve or execute any pro-
cess whatsoever or in making or attempting to make any arrest
within the limits of the Township, or to assault or beat any
such officer in the performance of his duty as aforesaid.

SECTION 7 - Any person or persons who shall violate any of
the provisions of the Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof
before any Justice of the Peace be sentenced to pay a fine not
exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each offense, and cost
of prosecution, and in default thereof suffer imprisonment for
a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION 8 - All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsis-
tent herewith are hereby repealed.
