ORDINANCE NO. 4 - 2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX, CUMBERLAND
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1-95 WITH
RESPECT TO REPORTING ON THE STATUS OF OCCUPANCY OF
PARCELS OR UNITS BY LESSORS AND LANDLORDS.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township on April 5, 1995 enacted Ordinance No. 1-95 requiring lessors and landlords to report on the occupancy of parcels or units of real estate which have been rented or are available for rent and thereby providing to Middlesex Township a report each time a new lessee or tenant occupies a particular parcel or unit or when such lessee or tenant vacates such parcel or unit; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township has concluded it is no longer necessary for lessors and landlords to provide such information to Middlesex Township, there being no reason for Middlesex Township to any longer collect such information and require such reporting by lessors and landlords.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Township Supervisors in and for the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1-95 as enacted April 5, 1995 by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township is hereby repealed in its entirety.

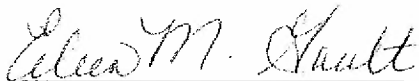
SECTION 2. All ordinances and resolutions and parts of ordinances and resolutions in so far as they are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

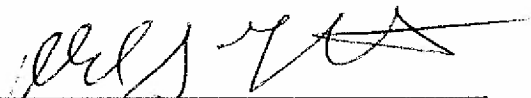
SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.
