ORDINANCE NO. 7 - 2013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLESEX, CUMBERLAND
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ABOLISHING THE LEVY AND
COLLECTION OF THE PER CAPITA TAX AND REPEALING
ORDINANCE 8-91.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 8-91 effective January 1, 1992, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township imposed a tax commonly known as the per capita tax on all persons 18 years of age or older residing in Middlesex Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes it is in the best interest of the residents of Middlesex Township no longer to levy, impose and collect such a tax commencing in 2014 and thereafter.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Middlesex, Cumberland County, as follows:

SECTION 1: The imposition, levy and collection of the per capita tax as established by Ordinance 8-91 under authority of the Local Tax Enabling Act is hereby abolished and ended commencing January 1, 2014.

SECTION 2: Ordinance 8-91 is hereby repealed.

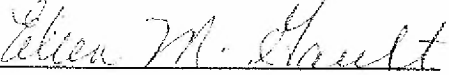
SECTION 3: The repeal of Ordinance 8-91 notwithstanding, nothing herein shall interfere with or affect the collection of any delinquent per capita taxes owed and any costs, interests and fines for non-payment thereof by any person subject to levy and payment of same prior to January 1, 2014.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with applicable law.

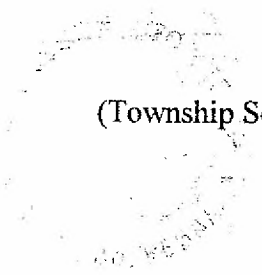
