RESOLUTION NO. 2009-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE REGULATIONS FOR PARK AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES PERTAINING TO THE POSSESSION AND USE OF FIREARMS.

WHEREAS, the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors has promulgated from time to time certain rules and regulations governing the use of park and recreational facilities of Middlesex Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend the current rules and regulations to address the possession and use of firearms on park and recreational property of Middlesex Township.

NOW THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. Paragraph 2, Prohibited Acts, subparagraphs j. and k. of the Regulations For Park and Recreational Facilities, is hereby amended as follows:

j. Possession of a firearm in violation of Pennsylvania law and the possession of any bows and arrows, airguns, paint guns, slingshots, fireworks or lethal or dangerous weapons, unless sanctioned by Middlesex Township.

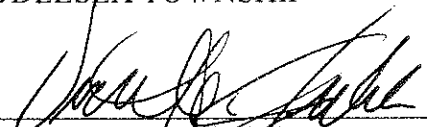
k. Hunting, trapping or the discharge of any firearm, except in the lawful use of self-defense.

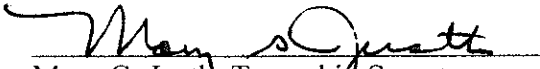
2. Except as specifically modified herein, the Regulations For Park and Recreational Facilities as previously adopted and amended shall remain in full force and effect.
