RESOLUTION NO. 2009-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA DESIGNATING, RE-DESIGNATING AND AUTHORIZING ADVANCE LIFE SUPPORT AND BASIC LIFE SUPPORT SERVICE PROVIDERS IN AND FOR MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, Middlesex Township desires to make available comprehensive life support services to the residents of Middlesex Township in the form of Basic Life Support ("BLS") and Advanced Life Support ("ALS"); and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure proper care and comprehensive life support services for residents of Middlesex Township, it is necessary to authorize BLS service and ALS service for Middlesex Township between and among various service providers in various geographical areas of Middlesex Township (the "Township").

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township as follows:

1. Silver Spring Township Ambulance and Rescue ("Silver Spring") is re-designated, designated as and authorized to be the primary BLS service provider for the following areas of the Township:
 - a. the Wertzville Road area, from North Middlesex Road (but not including North Middlesex Road) east to the Silver Spring Township boundary line;
 - b. those areas encompassing North Regency Woods, the Meadows, the Ridings, Deer Lane, Sherwood Drive, Bernheisel Bridge Road, Country Manor and associated fire boxes 133-04, 133-05, 133-06, 34-02 and 34-03; and
 - c. the South Regency Woods area, which was formerly serviced by Cumberland Goodwill EMS.

2. Except as noted in Paragraph 1, above, pertaining to those specific areas designated and re-designated to be serviced by Silver Spring and except as specifically otherwise noted below, Cumberland Goodwill EMS ("Cumberland Goodwill") is designated as and authorized to be the primary BLS service provider in the Township. West Shore Emergency Medical Services is designated as and authorized to be the second due based upon the present fire alarm box response plan.

3. Cumberland Goodwill is designated as and authorized to be the primary ALS service provider in areas with fire boxes currently assigned to North Middleton Township; those being fire boxes 239-01, 239-03 and 239-04, in the geographical area encompassing Trindle Road, Claremont Road to South Middlesex Road and the area on North Middlesex Road and west to the boundary line of North Middleton Township. Cumberland Goodwill is also designated as and authorized to be the primary ALS service provider in the geographical area of Shermans Dale fire box 34-01, which area includes the Spring Road area west, and east, to North Middlesex Road.

4. West Shore Emergency Medical Services ("West Shore") is designated as and authorized to be the second due ALS service provider in all areas identified in Paragraph 3, above.

5. West Shore is authorized as and designated to be the primary ALS service provider in the following areas of the Township:

- a. the Harrisburg Pike area, from the North Middleton Township boundary line north to the Silver Spring Township boundary line and associated fire box areas for fire boxes 239-02 and 133-02;
- b. the South Middlesex Road area and all areas east thereof to the Silver Spring Township boundary line and associated fire box area for fire box 133-01; and

- c. the area east of North Middlesex Road, (but not including North Middlesex Road) and associated fire box area for fire box 133-03, including the entire area presently being serviced by Silver Spring, being that area for fire boxes 133-04, 133-05, 133-06, 34-02 and 34-03.

6. Cumberland Goodwill is designated as and authorized to be the second due ALS service provider in all areas identified in Paragraph 5, above.

7. With respect to Interstate 81 in Middlesex Township, the following companies are designated as and authorized to be the primary and second due BLS and ALS service providers in the areas noted:

Silver Spring	BLS	Second due	From a point immediately north of and adjacent to Exit 52 (not including entrance and exit ramps at Exit 52 that are associated with fire box 133-96) to the Silver Spring Township boundary line
Cumberland Goodwill	ALS	Primary	Exit 49 to 52 (including entrance and exit ramps at Exit 52 that are associated with fire box 133-97)
West Shore	ALS	Second due	Exit 49 to Exit 52 (including entrance and exit ramps at Exit 52 that are associated with fire box 133-97)

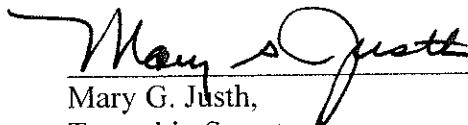
West Shore	ALS	Primary	From a point immediately north of and adjacent to Exit 52 (not including entrance and exit ramps at Exit 52 that are associated with fire box 133-96) to the Silver Spring Township boundary line
Cumberland Goodwill	ALS	Second due	From a point immediately north of and adjacent to Exit 52 (not including entrance and exit ramps at Exit 52 that are associated with fire box 133-96) to the Silver Spring Township boundary line

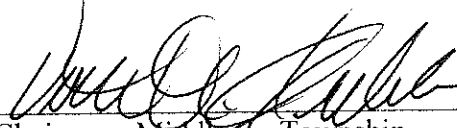
8. ALS and BLS service areas in Middlesex Township and the providers of such services, whether primary or second due, shall be subject to revision, change and approval from time to time as the Board of Supervisors in its sole discretion shall decide.
