RESOLUTION NO. 2015 – 6

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR THE SALE AND DISPOSITION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, from time to time, Middlesex Township (the “Township”) accumulates surplus personal property, obsolete personal property and property that has no practical use or function; and

WHEREAS, Section 1504(b) of the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. § 66504(b)) authorizes the sale and disposition of surplus personal property of the Township in the event an individual item or lots of items have an estimated fair market value of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township desires to establish a procedure in accordance with applicable law permit the sale of certain surplus personal property of the Township.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township as follows:

1. The Township Manager and the Township Roadmaster shall, upon their mutual agreement, be authorized to sell surplus personal property of the Township, when such individual items or lots of items have an estimated fair market value of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), from time to time, in such a manner consistent with this Resolution.
2. Any such sale of surplus property of the Township by mutual agreement of the Township Manager and Township Roadmaster shall be accomplished only in accordance with one of the following procedures, as they shall decide:

- a. The items or lots of items to be sold may be advertised for sale once in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the Township, not less than 10 days prior to the date set for auction of such property or the final receipt of bids for such property. The advertisement shall indentify the property to be sold, the manner of sale (auction or by sealed bid), the date, time and location where the property can be viewed or inspected and the date, time and location where the auction shall take place or the bids will be received and opened by the Manager and Roadmaster.
 - b. The items or lots of items to be sold may be advertised for sale and sold by use of on an online or electronic auction sale service, such a, but not limited to, Municibid, which specializes in the sale of government or municipal property.
3. This Resolution shall remain in effect unless subsequently amended or repealed by further Resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
