

## RESOLUTION 2025 - 8

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF AND MAKING AN APPOINTMENT TO THE POSITION OF DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF FOR MIDDLESEX TOWNSHIP.

**WHEREAS**, the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors has previously established and has appointed a qualified individual to serve as the Middlesex Township Fire Chief; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors believes it is in the best interest of the residents and property owner in Middlesex Township to establish and appoint a qualified individual to serve as Deputy Fire Chief in Middlesex Township in order to assist the appointed Fire Chief, and in the absence of the Fire Chief, to assume command as well as the other responsibilities of the Fire Chief in a fire or other emergency situation.

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township as follows:

1. The position of Deputy Fire Chief is hereby established for Middlesex Township effective the date of this Resolution. The qualifications, duties and responsibilities of the Middlesex Township Deputy Fire Chief shall be those as specified on the job description attached to this Resolution and incorporated by reference herein as "Exhibit A".
2. The annual compensation payable by Middlesex Township to the Deputy Fire Chief shall be \$15,000. Such compensation may be modified by the Middlesex Township Board of Supervisors by majority vote at any duly noticed public meeting of the Board from time to time without the need to amend this Resolution. The Deputy Fire Chief position shall be part time; accordingly, the position shall not qualify for any Middlesex Township employee benefits.
3. Robert Horning, Jr. is hereby appointed Deputy Fire Chief for Middlesex Township as having the experience and qualifications required by that position. As such, the Board has confidence in his ability to perform the duties and responsibilities as adopted through this Resolution and to otherwise assist the appointed Middlesex Township Fire Chief and in the absence of the Fire Chief, to assume command as well as the other responsibilities of the Fire Chief in a fire or other emergency situation.
4. The Deputy Fire Chief shall serve at the will of the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex Township.
